What information we collect about you

In General

We may collect information that does not identify you. This information relates to the device you use, the features you use in the app and the country and region you are in. We use this information to optimize our app. When you use our app, this information may be sent to servers located in the United Kingdom.

Use of cookies and other technologies to collect information

We do not use cookies to store information. We also do not link your information with information from other sources.

We do support digital advertising in our app. The first time an ad loads, we will ask if you consent to our advertising partner collecting information on your interactions with these ads to optimize the ads you receive. This information is not stored or used by RDC Media Ltd. directly. If you do not consent, no information will be collected.

Information collected automatically

We automatically collect information from your device when you use

our app. This information includes your device type and language, access times, your activities within the app and which pages you view. This helps us optimize future releases, we want to learn what you like and what you don't like so we can make Snoovies better.

With Whom We Share Your Information

We do not share your personal information with others, but we use Google Firebase to store any non-identifiable information about the use of our app.

Aggregated and non-personal information

We may share aggregated and non-personal information we collect under any of the above circumstances. We may also share it with third parties to develop and deliver targeted advertising on our apps. We may combine non-personal information we collect with additional non-personal information collected from other sources. We also may share aggregated information with third parties, including advisors, advertisers and investors, for the purpose of conducting general business analysis. For example, we may tell our advertisers the number of visitors to our app and the most popular features or services accessed. This information does not contain any personal information and may be used to develop website content and services that we hope you and other users will find of interest and to target content and advertising.

Third-Party Websites

You may click on a link to access other websites that do not operate under this Privacy Policy. For example, if you click on an ad, you may be taken to a website that we do not control. These third-party websites may independently solicit and collect information, including personal information, from you and, in some instances, provide us with information about your activities on those websites. When you delete the app, your downloads are also deleted. We may still retain certain information associated with your past use for analytical purposes and recordkeeping integrity, as well as to prevent fraud and take actions we deem necessary to protect the integrity of our service or our users, or take other actions otherwise permitted by law. In addition, if certain information has already been provided to third parties as described in this Privacy Policy, retention of that information will be subject to those third parties' policies.

Your Choices About Collection and Use of Your Information

You can choose not to provide us with certain information. We will not collect any information about you that you do not personally provide, besides the activities you perform within our app.

If you have provided us with an email address and receive unwanted emails, you can remove your email address from our records by clicking 'unsubscribe' within the email.

How We Protect Your Personal Information

We take appropriate security measures (including physical, electronic and procedural measures) to help safeguard your personal information from unauthorized access and disclosure. For example, only authorized employees are permitted to access information, and they may do so only for permitted business functions. In addition, we use encryption in the transmission of your sensitive personal information between your system and ours, and we use firewalls to help prevent unauthorized persons from gaining access to your personal information.

We want you to feel confident using our service. However, no system

can be completely secure. Therefore, although we take steps to secure your information, we do not promise, and you should not expect, that your personal information, searches, or other communications will always remain secure. Users should also take care with how they handle and disclose their personal information and should avoid sending personal information through insecure email.

Children's Privacy

Our service is a general audience site, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13.

Visiting Our Websites from Outside the United Kingdom
